## 2. Agency

#### \* Agency

> is the capacity of individuals to have the power and resources to fulfill their potential.

>The capacity, condition, or state of acting or of exerting power.

>The capacity of individuals to act independently and to make their own free choices.

\* The Family Farmers -Family faming is "a means of organizing agricultural, forestry, fisheries, pastoral and aquaculture production which is managed and operated by a family and predominantly reliant on family capital and labour, including both women's and men's. The family and the farm are linked, co-evolve and combine economic, environmental, social and cultural functions."

Account for 90% of all farms Small scale family farmers :

- > 84% of total family farmers, majority of them in Asia Pacific,
- producing 35% of world's food in just 12% of agricultural lands. But in Asia Pacific, family farmers produce 80% of the region's food.

- Ending hunger and poverty
- promoting biodiversity, land restoration, environmental sustainability, climate resiliency with mitigation benefits

## 2. Farmers' Agency

- An establishment engaged in doing business for another;
- A medium through which power is exerted or an end is achieved
- Farmers' Organizations (FOs) depending on national legal context, can be registered as an association, federation, trade union, non-government organization, non-stock corporation, limited company, cooperative.
- can be organized at local(village), sub national, national, regional, global levels.

Family Farmers for Climate Action World Rural Forum

24 national FOs in 16 countries in Asia, in 3 sub regions

4,294 sub national FOs

13M small scale women, men and young family farmers (crops, livestock,fisheries, forestry, herding, pastoralism Eg. AFA

Why Partner with FOs for Research and Innovation and Service Delivery? - 4S

- **SCOPE:** wider area coverage (different levels-provincial, national, regional, multi-country, etc)
- **SCALE:** membership base ensures outreach to individual farmers
- **SPEED**: proximity to local situation
- **SUSTAINABILITY:** natural exit/phase-out strategy

Strong and credible FOs are effective transmission channel/scaling actors for science and innovation
