Understand, promote and improve local knowledge is important





Co-creation process of capitalization of local knowledge

A consultation workshop with ALISEA members (Farners, researchers, academia, Government officers, CSOs, private sectors) to select cases Documentation of cases (farmer expert, local officer, media officer) Finalization of cases (with technical support from ASSET partners)



Participatory Action Research



PAR is a good approach, not only as developing new technology but it is a learning process.

LFA supports members to conduct AE systems such as: Labor saving rice system, integrated shade house (duck and vegetable), eco-frog, intercropping system, agroforestry, etc.



Co-creation process of PAR



- Farmers analyze problems and select topics for researches
- Farmers develop research frameworks (objectives, tools, program)
- Farmers implement and monitor
- Farmers assess result of research
- Farmer utilize research findings



- > Supporters facilitate analytical workshops
- Supporters facilitate planning workshop/ train farmers on data collection/research techniques
- Supporters coach the farmers
- Supporters facilitate analytical workshops
- Supporter help to disseminate findings, develop projects, mobilize resources, etc.

What works



- Capitalization need a balance view between science and local knowledge
- PAR works when it responds to problems of the farmers
- Policy influence works when farmers engage in a long term mechanism with strategic positioning

and what not



- Take a side between local and scientific knowledge
- PAR doesn't work when it responds to the interest of supporter not the farmers
- Policy influence doesn't work when farmers just attend random events
