For everybody during the field trip

- Listen carefully
- Formulate short, concise questions addressing any of the following:
 - *History*
 - *Technologies or other types of innovations and the results obtained*
 - *Organization*
 - *Link to marketing*
 - *Approaches & process followed including multistakeholder collaboration and cocreation*
 - *Other issues?*
- Don't monopolize, let other visitors ask as well
- (Try and group / sequence your questions by main topic)
- If enough time: don't hesitate to share (briefly) experiences that might be interesting to hear for the hosts

Volunteers needed to work extra for free!

- For each group: 2-3 people (different stakeholder groups) volunteer and/or are nominated formally to be in charge of the following
- Your role:
 - observing & listening, taking notes and photos,
 - Formulating synthetic answers to the 3 questions in next slide in the name of their group
- Towards or at the end of the field trip, the 2-3 of you will meet in the bus / evening or at the latest during breakfast on Thur, to compare / merge notes and prepare a synthetic oral report (5 mn) which will be shared in plenary on Thursday morning

3 questions to be addressed in your oral report

1. *What have been the 2-3 most striking / impressive things / aspects in what you were able to see, listen and discuss about AE “in the field” and with our hosts?*
2. What have been the most puzzling things / aspects in what you were able to see, listen and discuss about AE “in the field” and with our hosts ?
3. *Based on the field trip, formulate 3-4 specific **lessons** and/or **recommendations** the group might have which in its view might be of interest / value to the hosts on one hand and on the other hand to the TPP as a whole*
