








- Individuals design and put transformation initiatives into action in their environments.

- The global cohort contributes to the international conversation on agroecology by sharing experiences and good practices.








# Core Modell of the Academy:

#### Instructions given to the country teams:

The transformation initiative should be an activity that ...

- addresses a leverage point on agroecology in which, as the team you are, you feel you could make a difference on.
- you feel capable to do together in 10 months
- targets or involves other people beyond your team
- enables you to learn about leadership, transformation and agroecology



The transformation initiative could be seen as an experiment or prototype for learning. It does not need to be big.




